

You may get an AC3 file which contains Dolby Digital 5.1 6 channel sound which Nero 8 Ultra can Read into a slide show Video as background music. VLC Media player can play these on your PC.

OR you can use Adobe Audition to create and encode a WAV file with 6 "Interleaved" channels Which Nero can use properly.


How to use Adobe Audition 1.5 Multichannel Encoder to do this:



WMA Pro 6-channel option also works but sometimes the Surround Left and Surround Right channels seem to get Folded down into a Dolby Pro Logic type 4 channel sound after use of Nero. Perhaps this happens when Audition Only encodes the LFE channel as a "percent" of other channels.

The "interleaved, 6-channel wave file" export format is handled properly in Nero 8 Ultra Video slide shows.

Here are the settings inside a Nero 8 Ultra Video Slide show creation project which "force" the encoding of Dolby Digital 5.1 in the slide show output.



If NERO "SoundTrax" is used you must select the "Dolby Digital 5.1 6 full channels" option.
